It is Zahana's philosophy that development must be based on local needs and solutions proposed by local people. Participatory development means asking communities what they need. Working collaboratively with Zahana on their priorities a community claims ownership of their own development successes.

To realize a community's priorities, Zahana hires in-country experts to assist with specific tasks such as building a clean water system from the mountains to the village or a school. The villagers contribute their labor and locally available materials to every project.
